THE LATE HON. MR. POPE

Another old-timer has passed away. Mr. John Pope was left alone out of a group of brilliant statesmen who formed the government of Canada at Confederation. The late Mr. Pope was one of these. A man who had few advantages but a vast fund of common sense. His abilities were of a kind that did not fill the columns of newspapers, but were confined to the department where his chief work lay. He was a bosom friend of Sir John, who made the remark that in losing Mr. Pope he lost his best friend. The Department of Railways, over which Mr. Pope presided is not without a head. Several names have been mentioned the general impression points towards Mr. Colby. A report was published in the Montreal Gazette, of Tuesday last that Mr. Colby had received the post office, but it is in position to say that the report is entirely without foundation. Mr. Pope was buried at Cookshire where he resided before entering the cabinet.

A WELL TIMED REBUTT

The various charges made against the Secretary-Treasurer, members of the Town Council, and all who favored them, by the leaders of the "People's Ticket," have not yet slipped the memory of our readers. It would be well however to enumerate them.

1. That the taxes levied were not "exigible," and consequently the several voters who had not paid their taxes, could award without danger that their exigible taxes were paid.
2. That intimidation was used.
3. That the Secretary had acted partially and corruptly.
4. That in rejecting Mr. Davis' nomination paper the Secretary had acted illegally and that he would be made smart for it.
5. That no ballot could be a "manilla."

Besides these several specific charges, all sorts of general charges of corruption, intimidation, etc., were made against all who took any part in opposing the alleged of the clique to power. It is very easy to make categorical statements, but when an opportunity is given for the ventilation of such statements in court where no hearsay evidence is allowed, but where everything is conducted on a perfectly just and unbiased system, they very often "go in smoke." Such was the result of the recent election trials, about which the independent is very quiet. The above specific charges or statements are of two kinds, one of fact, the other of law, and in answer to them the Court held:

1. That all taxes must be paid before a ratepayer can vote or exercise any of the rights of a voter without being liable to a penalty.
2. That all taxes levied, including Court House tax, were exigible.
3. That no intimidation whatever was used.
4. That the Secretary had acted most impartially and was in no way culpable, but had shown himself a most capable and unbiased officer.
5. That the returning officer was clearly acting within his jurisdiction in examining the qualifications of each person signing the nomination paper, and rejecting it if found to be irregular.

When we remember the brag and bluster made on this point of law at a meeting in the Court House, the above decision proves either the insincerity of those who abused the Secretary for his action, or their very imperfect knowledge of the law on the subject.

AN HISTORICAL PERSONAGE

The benefit to the village has been undeniable and only express public opinion in saying that the best thanks of the Grenville people are due to Capt. Williamson, who chose to distribute his money in his native place, rather than save a few dollars as he might have done by building at Quebec or Montreal where there is every facility for such work. A few more public spirited men of the same calibre would make Grenville a prouder and happier place. The barges are nearly completed and probably this week may see the departure of the last ship carpenter, the painter taking his place. No doubt if there are any men in the village who consider they have talent for painting, permission may be given to exercise the art. When the river comes to life again and the boats are launched, we wish them God Speed as they were built with good intentions and should bring good fortune to their owner.

DEATH FROM VIOLENCE.

The Number of Those Dying from Unnatural Causes in England and Wales.

Few persons, except those who have been victims of the epidemic of Registrar General, realize the fact that more than 18,000 deaths are annually attributed to various forms of violence in England and Wales. From the recently issued Fifth Annual Report of the Registrar-General, we learn that the precise number in 1897 was 18,125, of which 15,618 were referred to accident or negligence, 2,324 to suicide, and 232 to murder or manslaughter. The total deaths from violence were equal to 0.24 in each million of the estimated population in the middle of the year, which were sold slightly exceed the rates recorded in two immediately preceding years, 1895 and 1896, but was lower than the rate in any previous year of which we have record. The death-rates from violence in 1897 showed very considerable variations in the different registration counties, and, generally speaking, were far higher.

engaged in mining and industrial occupations, than in those counties whose populations are mainly engaged in agriculture. The lowest county rates per million in 1897 were 430 in Buckinghamshire, 438 in Bedfordshire, and 456 in Cornwall; the rates in the counties ranged upwards to 704 in Lancashire, 716 in London, 719 in Devonshire, 743 in Warwickshire, and 763 in Herefordshire. With regard to the 15,618 deaths resulting from accident and negligence, the proportion to a million living in England Wales was 549, and was lower than in any previous year except in 1894, when the accident-rate was 542 and 536. The death-rate from accidental violence is, however, higher among the males than among females, and in 1897 it was 808 and 304 per million respectively in the two sexes. But for the inexorable logic of the Registrar-General's figures it would be difficult to believe that there are more than 11,000 males (including, of course, a large proportion of children) are killed outright annually in England, in addition to a still larger number more or less permanently disabled by accidental violence. The 11,000 deaths of males

FROM ACCIDENTAL VIOLENCE in 1897 included 807 from accidents in mines, 714 from railway accidents, 1,316 from accidents from other vehicles and horses, 2,400 due to falls, blows, machinery, &c., occurring for the most part in industrial occupations, 1,084 to burns, scalds, and explosions, 2,219 to drowning, 1,013 (mostly infants) to suffocation, and 524 to poison. The 234 deaths ascribed to suicide in 1897 gave a rate of 80 per million, corresponding with the rate in 1899 and 1898, but exceeding the rate in any other year on record. The rate from suicide in 1897 was 122 per million for males and 30 for females; it has long been known that the rate from suicide bears a somewhat constant relation to the amount of education in the various classes of the population; and it would appear that the number in the male sex who have been educated in the elementary schools has recently been advancing with national progress in elementary education. (The Lancet.)

John Bright's Funeral—The German Emperor—King Milan, etc.

John Bright was buried in a dismal quarter of the cemetery at Rochdale with befitting simplicity in regard to ceremony and amid manifestations of popular grief and respect which monarchs cannot command. To the vast majority of Englishmen the funeral oration of the dead tribune was preached in the House of Commons in the superb style to which Mr. Gladstone set forth the virtues of his lifelong friend. To the cynical observer the most curious feature connected with John Bright's death and burial has been the fulsome eulogies passed upon him by certain newspapers, who only a few years ago could never find adjectives strong enough to express their hatred of the great Liberal orator.

King Milan, after a wild revel in Vienna by way of a preliminary carousal, has gone off to Constantinople to investigate Oriental pleasures. Since he has been out of Serbia he has to some extent overcome his dread of assassination, but he has not yet been able to steel himself in the face of the possibility of a sudden attack. In all other respects royalty is doing quite well.

In Germany Kaiser Wilhelm continues his extraordinary activity. He has made a great display of his ability. On Wednesday he attended Prince Bismarck's dinner to members of the Reichstag, and ate among other things, oysters, roast beef, sucking pig, trout, young bear, roast beef, suckling pig, with truffles, lobsters, French foie, ducks, and quails, all of which indicates a strong digestion as he still lives. He was not afraid to mix his drinks, but took mostly old Burgundy and sweet Cyprus. After the old Kaiser was able to chat the Deputies and converse with them on every non-political question in Germany. He had been on the Chancellor, who had addressed familiarly as Bismarck, smoking his long pipe, but smoked cigars himself and invited others to do so.

THE MORRISON CASE.

Much has been written, and more has been said about this now notorious personage, who would furnish a first-class material for a thrilling novel of the style of "Rob Roy."

The trouble lies evidently in a failure on the part of Morrison and his friends to secure sympathy for a wronged man, from a natural adherence to the maintenance of constituted authority. Unfortunately there is a strong tendency in the present day to resist all authority and to disregard the laws of man as well as of God. While our sympathy should always go out towards a man who has been wronged, yet sympathy should not be allowed to interfere with the enforcement of those laws which are our only safeguard for the protection of life and property. It can hardly be supposed that under the British flag, in a country governed by British laws, that one man can be allowed, under any circumstances, whatsoever, to shoot another, without at least an investigation being made into the circumstances which attended the victim's death. It has often happened that one man has shot another in a purely accidental manner, yet nevertheless, he is entitled to go free without a trial. Our sympathy for Morrison is strong, for many reasons. We believe in the fact that he was an honest, industrious man, whose hard earnings had been taken from him by a scheming sharper. It would appear from our present information that Warren, the victim of Morrison's pistol was not a rival, but an adventurer and a gambler, who had boasted that he was a good shot and that he did not get shot, and he would bring him in dead. Hearing of these boasts and probably believing that it was a question of life or death when Warren drew his revolver, it cannot be a matter of great surprise, that acting under that instinct of self preservation, common to the race, Morrison should have shot the supposed villain. That, however, is a question for a jury to decide after hearing the evidence. While Morrison's wrongs have been great, and while he has our sympathy, yet it is not our desire to see any justice denied, and the administration of Justice interfered with. There is no doubt Morrison must be taken or driven out of the country. However, we cannot approve of the unnecessary harshness of the course adopted by Judge Dugas, and must indignantly repudiate the insulting statement of Constable Bissonette that the people of the district are savages, and keep quiet simply because they are afraid of the police stationed there. The effect of such remarks is to enrage the populace, who, if they wished could make Mr. Bissonette and his constables suddenly aware that they had business elsewhere. We do not know that this officer has ever shown much bravery, except when at a safe distance from the Highland Scotch race, when safe among his own friends. The Quebec Government should have taken the present steps when the murder occurred. But to allow nine to continue to roam about, a whole settlement for allowing Morrison to live among them during that time, while the authorities whose special duties were to arrest him remained inactive, is, to say the least, absurd if not criminal.

GRAND JURY.

Over \$200,000 worth of farm implements are to be sold by the Grand Jury this morning.

Seventy-five orphan boys, ranging from ten to sixteen years of age, have arrived in St. John's from England.

An effort is being made in Winnipeg to arrange for an excursion to induce Ontario farmers to go to Manitoba.

In the Montreal Police Court yesterday O. Valois, a druggist, was fined \$75 for selling laudanum without a label on the bottle.

A band of about 25 children, sent out by the English Government, have arrived at Quebec for distribution amongst Canadian farmers.

The Montreal City Council yesterday passed appropriations for the current year, amounting to \$2,372,770, an increase of \$425,094 over last year.

The new Toronto, Hamilton, and Buffalo Railway Company are progressing with their construction for the new line.

The village of Wainwright, though only asked for a bonus of \$20,000, unanimously voted the sum of \$30,000.

From various lake ports our correspondents report that vessels will commence making regular trips some time next week.

It is evident that navigation will be general on all the lake routes two or three weeks earlier than usual.

The working tailors of London (Ont.) have struck for an advance of wages. With three exceptions the employers refuse their demands, but the men say they are prepared for a long strike, and claim that their rate of pay is lower than that of neighboring cities.

The lady students who are anxious to study medicine at McGill College, Montreal, are collecting for the new hospital of \$250,000. It is understood that they have \$12,000 in hand, and that the faculty have promised to undertake the work as soon as that amount is made up to \$50,000.

A sailor on board a schooner in Baltimore found a cockroach in his soup, and, as one would expect, he threw it away.

Under recent legal rulings all the concert halls in New York City, where liquors are sold, were closed on Saturday.

SPRING CLEANING.

Now when spring is opening and when it is specially necessary to have all houses thoroughly cleaned, particularly the houses of the poor, who are perhaps worse housed than in any other metropolis in the world, the weather considered, it seems a fitting time of the year to call the attention of the Corporation and of the Health Department in particular to this cruelty of turning the water supply off from the poor.
